In addition to her acting work, Williams-Paisley is an accomplished writer with her first full-length book *Where the Light Gets In* landing on the New York Times best-seller list in 2016. The memoir highlights the impact of her mother's diagnosis of dementia and explores how she and her family coped with the illness, care and the emotional then physical loss of her mother Linda. Following her caregiving experience, Williams-Paisley has become a spokesperson for the Alzheimer's Association.

At the 45<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting & Awards Ceremony, Williams-Paisley will share her experience as a caregiver while navigating her additional roles of wife to country singer-songwriter Brad Paisley and mother to their two children. A book signing is open to attendees following the event – books will be available for purchase.
